They are collecting the Box Tops for Education. They want to put the box tops in the envelopes when they mail the letters back and forth. Please save your box tops and turn in to Dee at the meeting. These box tops can also be found on Hamburger Helper and other items, please be sure to look for these box tops on all your boxed items, not just cereal. A sample of the box top is below.

This is a recipe Dee Roman got from her sister that is really good. Hope you like it.

SNACK CRACKERS

70-90 oz. of various crackers (cheap ones like from Dollar General & Wal-Mart)

1 can cashews

1 can mixed nuts (if you like lots of nuts use the large size cans)

3 brown paper bags

2 pkgs. Hidden Valley dry ranch dressing

1 bottle Orville Redenbacher - Buttery Flavor Popcorn oil

1. Take 1 brown bag and add $\frac{1}{2}$ amount of crackers and 1 can of nuts.
2. Take 2nd brown bag and add the other can of nuts and remaining crackers.
3. Add 1 pkg. of Hidden Valley dressing to each bag.
4. Shake both bags.
5. Take 3rd brown bag and add the ingredients from the first 2 bags to the 3rd bag.
6. Drizzle a bottle of popcorn oil over crackers. Shake every 15 minutes for 1 hour.
7. Spread out on wax paper or paper towels to dry.

This will fill two $\frac{1}{2}$ gallon ice cream buckets.

It's delicious – ENJOY!!!
