Beat together for 2-3 minutes:

1 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup Crisco

2 Tbsp dry Dream Whip (1/2 pkg)

2 tsp flavoring ($\frac{1}{2}$ almond & $\frac{1}{2}$ vanilla) or ($\frac{1}{2}$ butter & $\frac{1}{2}$ vanilla)

Mix together:

$\frac{1}{4}$ cup flour

$\frac{2}{3}$ cup COLD water

Add:

1 bag (2#) of powdered sugar

Beat on high for 10 minutes, (12-15 minutes for a double batch)

Keep in refrigerator or freezer. Warm overnight before using.

Snickers-Apple Dessert


Chop Snickers up with the food chopper.

Place them in a baking dish and sprinkle the chopped candy bars over the apples.


Bake at 350° for 15 minutes!!!
