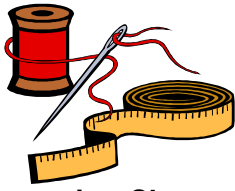
Shopping/tour in Quad Cities, evening at Geneseo's community Christmas with live Christmas scenes in store windows and performance by Moline Boy's Choir
