Apple Bundles

(a Pampered Chef recipe)

Slice apples using Apple Peeler/Corer/Slicer.

Unroll refrigerated crescent rolls, and cut each triangle in half lengthwise to end up with 16 triangles of dough.

Place 3 or 4 apple slices at wide end of each strip and roll up.

Preheat oven to 375 degrees.

Arrange bundles on the pizza stone and bake 25-30 minutes or until golden brown.

You can add cinnamon and sugar if you'd like.

If desired, drizzle powdered sugar glaze on top after partially cooled.
